Purpose of the role

Part of the Plumbing and Heating Team, responsible for carrying out water compliance tasks and reactive plumbing repairs to the Estate's private water supply & building infrastructure.

Key responsibilities

- Develop and maintain positive working relationships with all customers.
- Carry out legionella control (L8) tasks to ensure the Estate is compliant and complete associated remedial repairs.
- Support Senior Plumbing & Heating Engineer in the management of the Estate's Private Water Supply.
- Assist with the installation, chlorination and testing of temporary water supplies for events.
- Carry out general reactive plumbing repairs across the Estate.

- Availability to be on-call at least 18 weeks per year (including every 3rd weekend)
- Flexibility to work out of normal hours when required.
- Be willing to undertake further training to broaden skillset.
